The total samples of two ECE centres, teachers, children, in a rural area of Bojanala Region of North West Province in South Africa were selected randomly; observations and semi-structured interviews were conducted. The key findings of the research indicated that factors such as; large enrolment and inadequate resources had a negative influence on children's play habit and are a challenge to ECE teachers. Some of the teachers did not have the necessary skills and expertise needed in the ECE classroom. The researcher recommended that Ministers of Education at the National, Provincial and Local levels take definite measures to improve in-service training for teachers of ECE. - 2. Use **AND** to combine keywords of different topics
- 3. Use quotes "" to search an exact phrase
