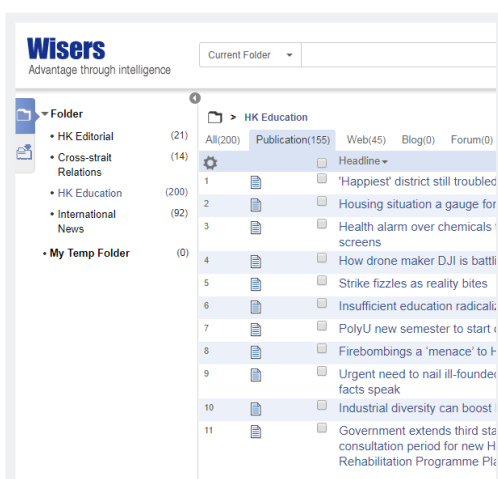

A great place to search for current and historical news articles, WiseNews collects local news from Chinese and English newspapers e.g. Apply Daily, Ming Pao Daily, am730, SCMP, The Standard, and Hong Kong Government News. On the left side of the WiseNews platform, the folder "HK Education" gives you a quick look at today's news on Hong Kong education.
