# Search the EBSCO database & the Library catalog AT ONCE with



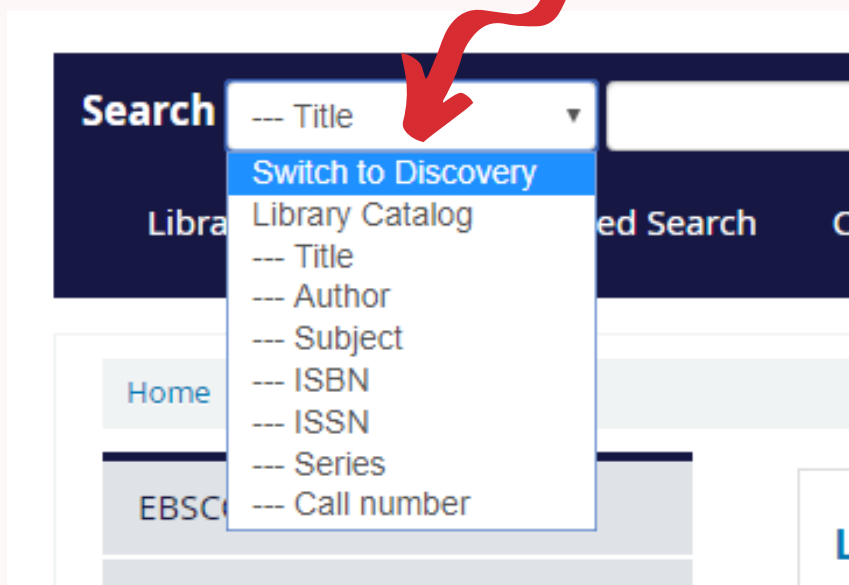
## KOHA DISCOVERY SEARCH



The Library catalog KOHA (koha.yccece.edu.hk) is now connected with the EBSCO database. By switching the search to "**Discovery**" (see the screenshot on the right), you can search both the database e-resources and the Library catalog at once.

**Discovery Search** gives you the power to search and access e-resources from EBSCO and physical materials at the Library using just the Koha library catalog. You don't need to go separately to the EBSCO database to look for e-resources.

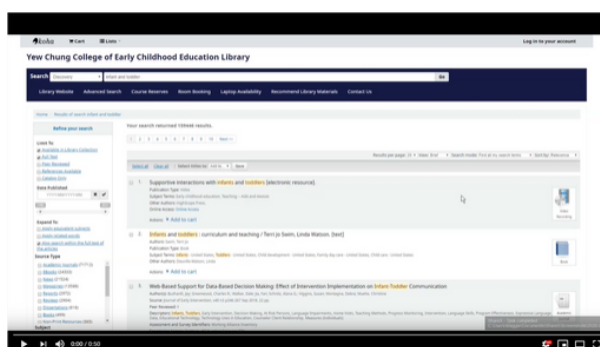

We have just introduced the Koha Discovery Search above, where you can search both Library print materials and the EBSCO database e-resources at the same time. Actually, it is the same way around! You can search for print books on the EBSCO database platform. It is like the Koha Library catalog and the EBSCO Database have gotten married and now, they share the same information.

This means, besides e-resources, you can find print books and DVD available at the Library on the EBSCO Database platform. As mentioned previously, you no longer need to look for e-resources and physical items on different places!

## Searching the Library E-resources in Google Scholar



If you don't like using databases and the library catalog, how about searching on Google? All you need to do is to link up Google Scholar with YCCECE Library. Once you have set up the Library Link, you can search in Google Scholar and gain access to articles that are subscribed by the Library. However, Google Scholar looks for e-resources only and you won't be able to find the Library subscribed e-books and print materials, though there may be free e-books from other sources. Have a look and see what you can find!

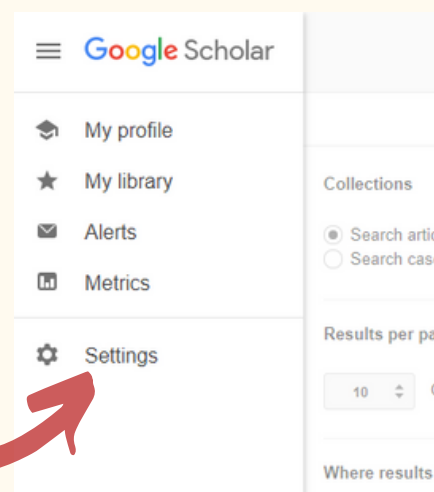
### 4 Quick Steps to Set up Google Scholar Library Link

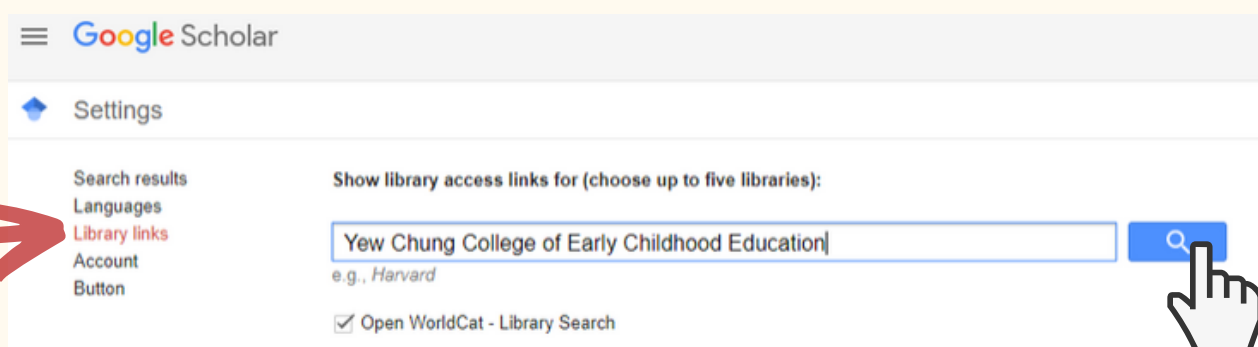
1 Go to

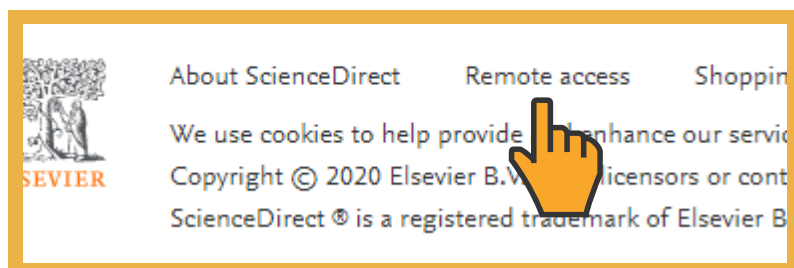
