Come and discover our 80 newly acquired books! Maybe you will find the best book for your next storytelling. These are some of the new titles

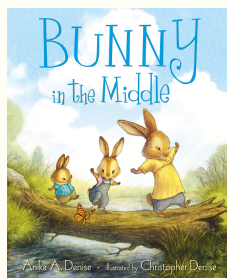

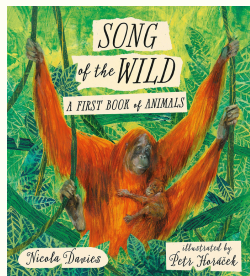




3. How to save hours and hours writing in-text citation and reference?


