

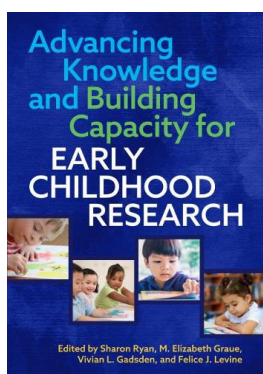
The SCMP delivers news and analyses on Hong Kong, China and Worldwide in English.
