

We are delighted to announce that our library is named as Kidsploration Library, following the heartening success of the inaugural 'Distinguished Yew Chung Educators' campaign. The naming ceremony was held on Saturday, 23 October 2021 in recognition of the legacies of the four inaugural Yew Chung Educators and the generous support of our fellow educators, supporters and friends, as well as the matching gift from the Yew Chung Education Foundation.

"Kidsploration" is a name inspired by the work of one of our honourees, the late **Ms Cecilia KAM Oi-ping**, former Early Childhood Principal at YCIS–HK. It is also a name commemorating three other Yew Chung pioneering educators: **Ms LAM Ching-lan**, former Early Childhood Principal at YCIS–HK, **Mr Bob PARKIN**, former Development Consultant at YCIS-HK Secondary, founding Principal at YCIS-Shanghai and YCIS-Beijing, and **Ms SUEN Kwan-hon**, former Chinese Curriculum Researcher at YCEF, all of whom had made significant contributions to the Yew Chung/Yew Wah Family, and in the education space.

APA style is a writing style and format for academic documents such as scholarly journal articles and books. And it's the College's requirement for all student assignments to be submitted by following the 7th edition of APA Style in both citations and references. This workshop highlights the key rules and referencing formats in the 7th edition of <u>the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association</u>.


Mac Barnett, author of the Klassen-illustrated picture books Sam & Dave Dig a Hole and others.

The Canadian author-illustrator, Jon Klassen, is famous for his signature sly humour.

He first children's book, I want my hat back (2011) was described as "not just another bear story", and "the joy of this book lies in figuring out the explicit plot from the implicit details in the pictures." It won ALA's Geisel Award and was shortlisted in CILIP's Kate Greenaway Medal. The sequel, This is not my hat (2012) stayed on the New York Times Bestseller list for 40+ weeks.


He is also the author, illustrator and co-creator of many other children's books. His works are now displayed at the Kidsploration Library until the end of November.
