Generate Citation Using Mendeley

Don't work hard, work **SMART**.

On April 3, the Library did a Zoom workshop on Mendeley, a research management tool, and some of the basic functions were introduced.



More specifically, on how to manage PDF files, highlight text and make notes, how to quickly find the PDF that contains the information you need, how to collaborate on a PDF file, and how to generate in-text citation and references. The Library has put together a new Mendeley Guide, available on the Library website that captures all of these "how-tos".

MENDELEY GUIDE

Generating In-Text Citation & References





The citation generation function works with **Microsoft Word** and **LibreOffice Writer** documents. After installing the MS Word or LibreOffice Plugin in Mendeley Desktop, the insert citation button will be available for use in the word document. When you press the insert in-text citation or bibliography button, the citation or references will be generated in the citation style you have chosen in Mendeley. Yup, APA is just one of many citation styles. It is mostly used in Psychology and Education fields.



Some operating systems (OS) DO NOT work well with Mendeley Desktop, please <u>click here</u> to check if your device is compatible. Even if an OS is not supported, Mendeley Desktop might still operate to a satisfactory level.
