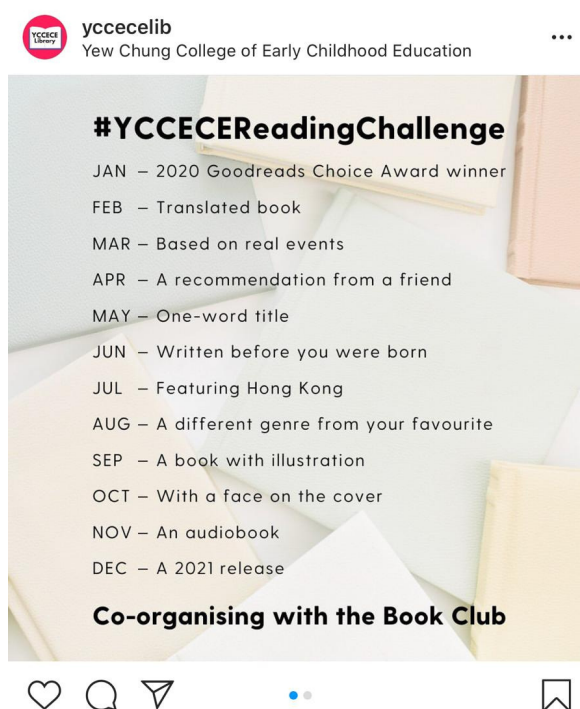
NEW YEAR ... NEW CHALLENGE!

Do I have to read books in English? Can I read books in Chinese?

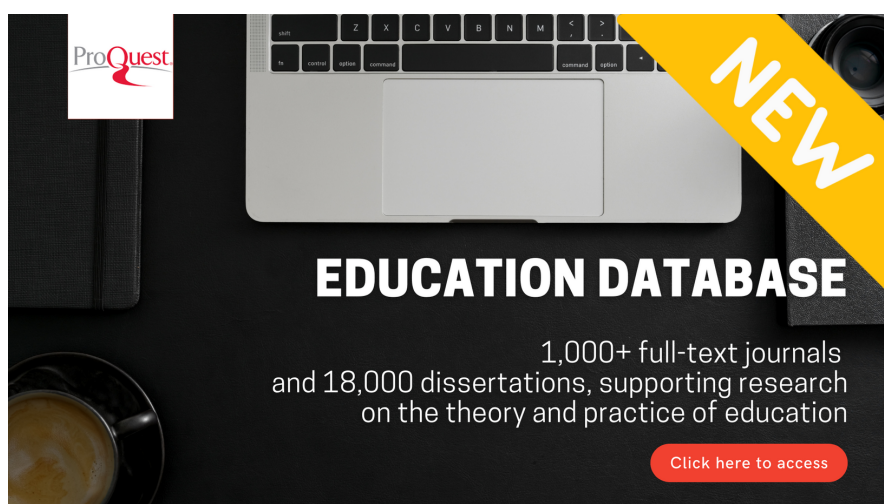
You can – in fact, you can read books in any language, not just English or Chinese.

Database - ProQuest Education Database

The Library is pleased to inform you that in order to continue to develop our online library resources for teaching, learning and research, and to supplement our current EBSCOhost Research Database, which includes Academic Search Complete and ERIC (Education Resources Information Center), the Library has just subscribed to the ProQuest Education Database. The database includes over 1,000 full-text journals and 18,000 dissertations, supporting research on education theory and practice.



Facilities - Rotary Trimmer and Laminating Service

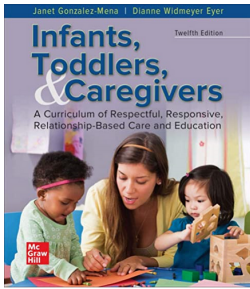
Preparing teaching kits and posters is easier now than it ever has been! The rotary trimmer and laminator are now available at the Library next to the self-check machine.

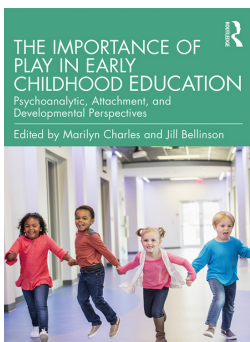
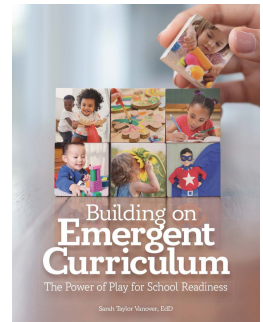
