
MASTERING THE ART OF STORYTELLING

Whole Book Approach

The Whole Book Approach focuses on the picture book as a visual art form and invites children to make meaning of text, art, and design-the whole book. This critical engagement with the picture book as an art form helps educators and caregivers create interactive storytimes that facilitate discussions rather than traditional read-aloud times. In other words, the Whole Book Approach is a means of reading **with** children instead of reading **to** them.

The selected books can be used as tools to open meaningful conversations with children on important topics, such as diversity and environmentalism as well as on critical developmental areas such as empathy, confidence, resilience, and special needs.
